The EU Global Diaspora Facility (EUDiF) is the first EU-funded project to take a global approach to consolidate efforts on diaspora engagement for development. EUDiF supports all actors in the diaspora-development ecosystem to engage and collaborate more effectively with each other.

## WHY

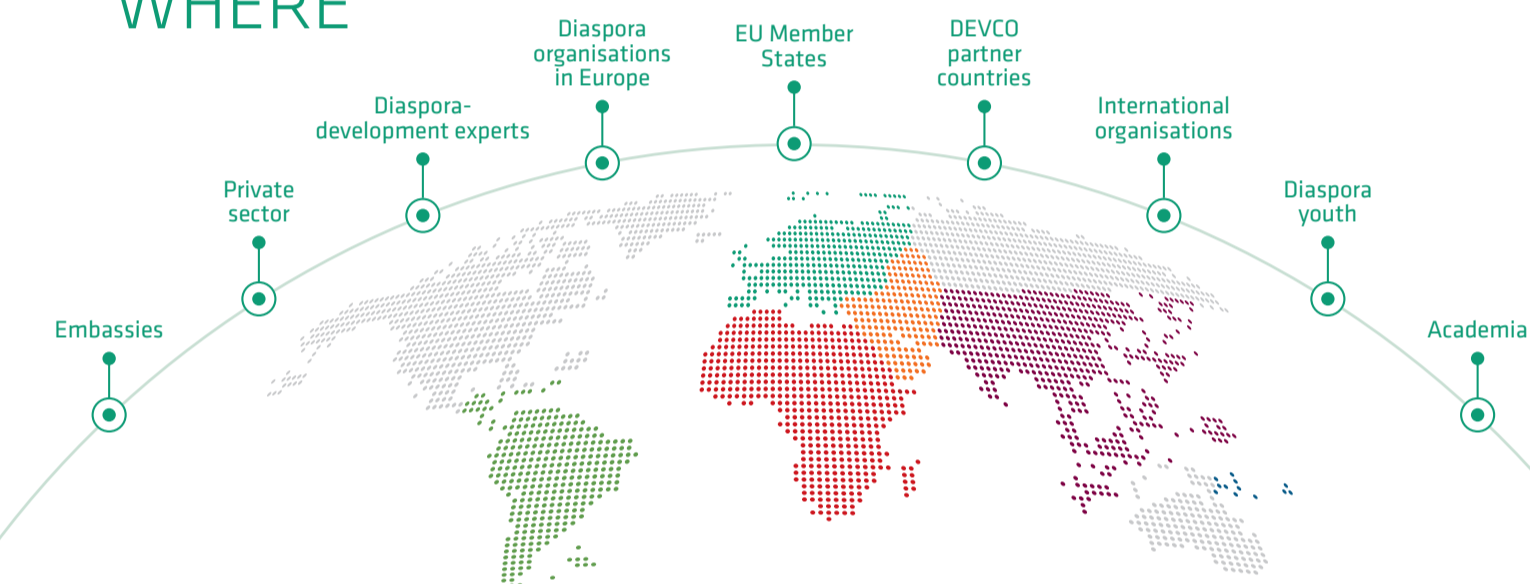
Diaspora are powerful agents of development thanks to their unique transnational understanding and mobility. Historically, however, dialogue and collaboration have been fragmented, with emphasis on bilateral cooperation.

There is growing interest in both Europe and DEVCO's partner countries to enhance diaspora-development cooperation. Diaspora are also calling for ways to formalise their contributions at EU-level and maximise their contributions to development. EUDiF seeks to answer this call.
