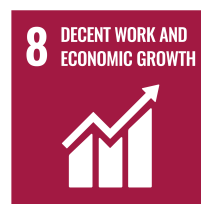

Objective(s)

The project aims to mobilise the skills of Moroccans living in Belgium in a sustainable way by supporting productive investments to contribute to the development of the Kingdom of Morocco.

Main activities

1) An innovative communication campaign to identify and mobilise investment project holders; 2) Entrepreneurs have access to practical training, coaching by entrepreneurship professionals, access to a hotline to ask questions and networking opportunities; 3) Personalised post-creation coaching in Morocco.

(Expected) Results

Moroccans living in Belgium are mobilised and accompanied individually to create and develop their business in Morocco. The Maghrib Belgium Impulse programme has so far identified and accompanied 40 beneficiaries - of which 27 in pre-creation and 13 in post-creation - with sectoral and geographical diversity.
