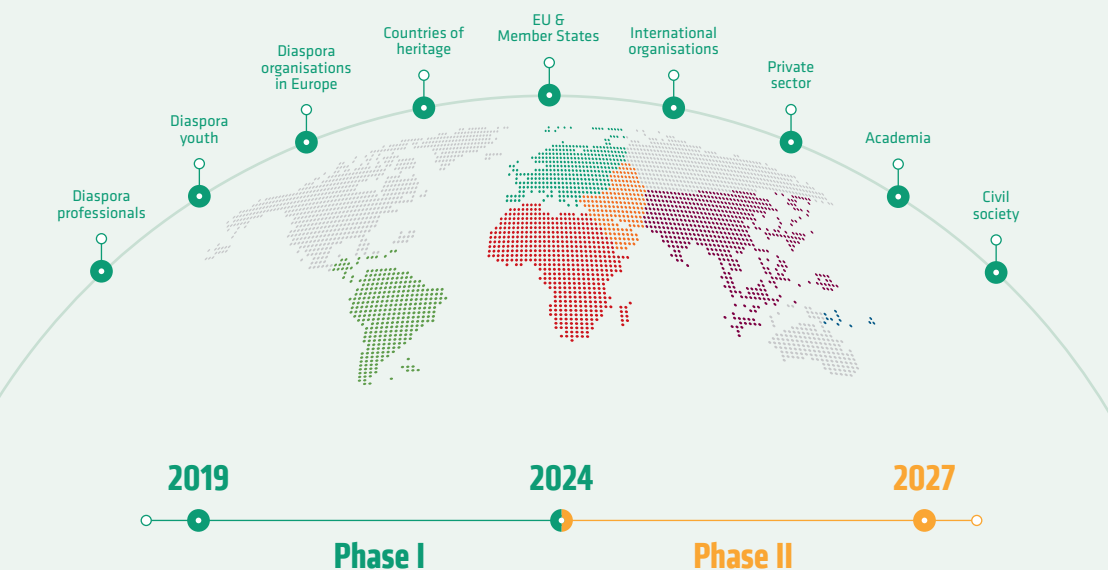

Diaspora engagement is proven to drive job creation, stimulate innovation and create more inclusive societies whilst strengthening links between the EU and its partner countries around the world.

EUDiF began in 2019 as the EU's first global project to harness the potential of diaspora engagement for development. The project takes a holistic approach, emphasising the value of human and social capital in addition to financial capital.

The project supports public institutions and diaspora organisations alike. Following a successful pilot phase which included capacity development, research and dialogue facilitation, in 2024 the project added a grant mechanism to its services, empowering diaspora organisations to run their own projects.

Drawing on over 40 projects across the two phases, as well as research and outcomes from dialogue activities, EUDiF has built a public-access digital knowledge hub on diaspora engagement including over 120 country profiles, a living database of practices, extensive case studies, an interactive map and more.
